- Student's name
- Student's GPA (unweighted, as of 1/15/17)
- Student's address
- Parents/Guardians
- Extracurricular activities, listing the most significant and years of participation and honors/awards, including clubs, organizations, and non-classroom music and theater
- Student government, listing positions and participating years
- Organized sports, listing high school sports played and participating years and honors/awards
- Community activities, listing most significant community activities (other than CAS project) and dates of participation
- Employment: if you hold or have held a job during the school year or summer, please provide specifics about employer, position/duties, and dates
- Academic honors, listing only the most significant (no more than 10 lines)

CAS Project Report: *On separate paper, format a document using Microsoft Word or similar formatting software and using 12-point font, provide a description of your major CAS project, including the following points. Limit your description to no more than 1500 words.*

- Informative title
- Brief description of project, including contact information for at least two individuals (not family) as references to validate project
- How and why you decided to pursue this project
- How you developed and executed the project, including contacts you made, organizations and people who helped you, and their roles
- Who directly benefited from your project, perhaps including, to indicate efficacy of project,
 - numbers or groups of individuals and how you determined these numbers
 - tables/charts/diagrams (no more than one page)
- Who indirectly benefited from your project, perhaps including
 - numbers or groups of individuals and how you determined these numbers
 - tables/charts/diagrams (no more than one page)
- If project were to be repeated, what components you would retain and what you would do differently, explaining why
- Whether or not project will continue without you, explaining why or why not
- How this project has affected you
